- 1.The AAYHS shall be guided by AQHA rules whenever AAYHS rules do not apply. Rules will be strictly enforced by our show Stewards, our Board of Directors & Staff and if necessary the Franklin Co. Sheriff Deputies. Failure to comply will result in a scratch with no refund, removal from grounds and possible ban from future AAYHS Shows.
- 2. Stalls: Each horse/pony MUST have a stall of their own, including those entered only in contesting or fence. OEC does not allow sharing a stall, due to State regulations. Stalls not used must be re-assigned by AAYHS Show Office only. ALL EQUINE MUST have bedding in their stall. ALL STALLS ARE 10X10, We do not provide mats, however you may bring your own.
- 3. Stalls: Exhibitors/Stables desiring block stalling MUST send their stall reservations and payment together in ONE packet & ONE money order or cashiers check. NO PERSONAL CKS WILL BE ACCEPTED. If 4 or more stalls are requested, use the BLOCK STALL FORM, available on the website. Entries may be sent in with stall reservations or after stall reservations are made, but NOT PRIOR TO RESERVING A STALL. Stalls are assigned first come, first served. FALSIFICATION OF BIRTH CERT. or REG. PAPERS MAY RESULT IN A PERMANENT BAN FROM THE AAYHS.
- 7. <u>ALL HORSES and PONIES</u> must submit a current neg. Coggins and a CVI (Certificate of Veterinary Inspection). It is preferred your coggins is submitted your entries. Coggins & CVI must include the dates of our show. The CVI must be dated within 30 days of the show and MUST be submitted prior to the show, by mail or email. Coggins are valid for one year from the date the blood is drawn. Failure to present these forms upon arrival at show will result in a scratch with no refund. See pg. 1 for more info.
- 8. Exhibitors must enter ring in proper attire. AHSA approved helmets must be worn in all mounted Hunt Seat or Fence classes. Helmets or western hat may be worn in other classes. - 9. Animals measuring 58" or less may enter as a horse or pony, NOT BOTH.
- 10. <u>Post entries for Session 2 & 3 will close at the start of the previous session. Post entries</u> for Session 1 will close at 8pm the night before.
- 11. The exhibitor is responsible for coordinating entries between the arenas. Every attempt will be made as the show progresses to avoid time conflicts between the arenas, but the AAYHS cannot guarantee the lack of conflicts.
- 12. No horse or pony may be shown Western by one exhibitor & Ranch by another exhibitor.
- 13. DOUBLE ENTRY: a) No 2 or more exhibitors may show the same horse in the same <u>age</u> class. b) Exhibitors may show one or more horses in Trail, Contest, Fence, Ranch Riding, classes only. c) Exhibitors may not double enter with one or more entries in Showmanship, Horsemanship, Equitation, Pleasure, Hunter Under Saddle or Ranch Rail.
- 14. Exhibitors participating in ALL Walk/Trot Divisions are limited to Walk/Trot classes only and may not enter any class that is NOT Walk/Trot. See W/T Division rules (Page 7).
- 15. Registration papers must be submitted with entries if exhibitor is participating in class designated for registered horses/ponies. The horse/pony does not have to be registered in the exhibitor's name.
- 16. All ponies will be measured at the show, regardless of papers submitted with entries. **See page 19 for measuring times.**
- 17. Any protest or inquiry regarding the conduct of a class must be directed to the Show Steward. Stewards are located in the Paddock areas (not in the Show Office).
- 18. Formal protests must be filed with the Show Office within 1 hour after the completion of the class in question. A \$200.00 CASH deposit is required and is forfeited if the protest is not upheld. Protests involving class results or missed classes WILL NOT be accepted. No refund will be given for missed classes. Forms are available in Show Office and will not be accepted without protest fee.
- 19. Show management reserves the right to split, cancel or change location of any class.
- 20. TRAIL/FENCE WARM-UP TIMES: Please see LUNGEING/WARM UP SCHEDULE. All courses will be closed 1 hr. prior to start of class. Be respectful of your times on obstacles & fences.
- 21. CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES: Exhibitors placing 1st or 2nd in their classes are eligible for championship classes. Exhibitor is responsible for entering the appropriate Championship class in the Show Office. There is no entry fee for championship classes. W/T 10-13 & 14-18 may not participate in any Championship Class. ENTRIES WILL CLOSE ½ HR. PRIOR TO THE START OF THE 1st CLASS OF EACH CHAMPIONSHIP SECTION.
- 22. All dogs must be kept on a leash and out of paddocks & arenas.
- 23. AHSA approved helmets must be worn by anyone (Exhibitor & Adults) warming up or jumping fences. AHSA approved helmets must be worn by exhibitors participating in all Hunt/Over Fences/Wrkg Hunter classes. Traditional velveteen hunt caps are permissible in Showmanship only.

General Rules & Information continued:

- 24. DO NOT RIDE, LUNGE OR GRAZE YOUR HORSES/PONIES IN THE GRASSY AREAS AROUND OR NEAR THE EXPO ADMIN. OFFICES, BARNS, BUILDINGS OR ARENAS. THIS GRASS HAS BEEN TREATED. VIOLATORS WILL BE FINED.
- 25. All wheeled vehicles including: GOLF CARTS, SCOOTERS, BICYCLES, SKATEBOARDS, ETC. MUST be removed from stall area after 8 AM each day. DO NOT BLOCK YOUR ASILE WITH YOUR GOLF CART PER FIRE MARSHALL!
- 26. Registration papers must be presented to the Show Steward if an animal's breeding is questioned.
- 27. Horses and ponies will be required to enter the ring within 2 minutes after the first horse enters the class.
- 28. Western Riding, Reining, Ranch Horse Riding, Trail, Ranch Trail & Fence classes, will be run as follows: Exhibitors in these classes can run their pattern anytime during the allotted class block regardless of age/horse/pony. Once we have moved to the next block or jump height, the previous block is closed. Times will be announced during show.
- 29. No selling of new items will be permitted from the stall area.
- 30. After April 15, you cannot change horse classes to pony classes unless you scratch and re-enter at post entry fee. If your pony measures as a horse and you are entered in pony classes, you will be switched to the horse classes of the same (if applicable) at no additional charge. If in doubt, enter as a pony to avoid additional fees.
- 31. If you cover your tack stall, you MUST also install a smoke detector per State Fire Marshall.
- 32. The use of wireless headsets in any class is prohibited and will result in dismissal from the class and/or removal from the grounds with NO REFUND.
- 33. Entries in Reg. classes who cannot produce reg. papers upon receiving show packet will be scratched with NO refund.
- 34. TIME BLOCKS: If the course is idle in the last hour of allotted time last calls will be given including an announcement that class is closed.
- 35. NO STALLIONS ARE PERMITTED.
- 36. AAYHS reserves the right to refuse entries from any exhibitor or group.

- 4. Scoresheets WILL NOT be shared at the show.
- 5. Results will be announced at the end of each divisions last class once the tabulations are completed.
- 6. Scoresheets and results will be posted on the AAYHS website.

Awards for High Point Divisions will be announced and must be received at the show. Proof of placing is required if awards are not received in the arena.

Working Hunter Under Saddle Championship Class 1st & 2nd places from the 4 WHUS Classes. Must enter at show.

Rules & Information

Western & Hunt Seat classes:

- 1. Exhibitors competing in pattern classes (SHOWMANSHIP, HORSEMANSHIP & EQUITATION) must enter the ring in the order posted at the show office. Any deviation or conflict of this order MUST be approved by the Show Steward/Paddock.
- 2. REG. W. Pleasure/HUS COLOR BREED HORSE: These classes are open to horses that have registration papers in Pinto, Buckskin, Dun, Palomino, and any other recognized color breed registry. These horses are also eligible for Reg. Qtr. & Reg. Paint Pleasure/HUS if they are double registered. Papers must be sent with entries for any reg. class.
- 3. W. Pleasure/HUS No Reg. Qtr. or Paint: These classes are open to all horses or mules that are unregistered or have reg. papers in any other Stock type association. Reg. horses/ponies entering Reg. Qtr or Reg. Paint are not permitted to enter these classes.
- 4. **Reg. Non-Stock Horse & Pony W. Pleasure & HUS**: are not permitted to enter any Pleasure or HUS class specifically for **Reg. Paint or Qtr., Color Breed or No Reg. Qtr. or Paint, or Reg. Pony**. The 1st & 2nd places in the **Reg. Non Stock** classes are eligible for Championship classes, but must enter the horse or pony division, depending on the division you are showing for this entire show.
- 5. **Reg. Non-Stock** refers to the following: Fjords, Gypsy Vanners, Haflingers, ANY gaited breed (for example).
- 6. Hunter Showmanship horses/ponies may be shown in a bridle or halter.
- 7. No horse/pony may cross enter a Western Showmanship/Ranch Showmanship or Western Pleasure/Ranch class at this show, regardless of the number of exhibitors showing said horse or pony.
- 8. Exhibitors in ALL Hunt Seat and Over Fences classes must wear a helmet with a harness.

- 2. Walk/Trot Ranch 9 & Under will have High Point & Reserve High Point with Ranch Rail as the tie breaker class. Classes for HP: Ranch Rail, Ranch Riding & Ranch Trail.
- 3. Walk/Trot 9 & Under 1st & 2nd places may participate in the designated Championship classes. Exhibitor is responsible for entering the appropriate championship class. There are no entry fees for Championship classes.
- 4. Walk/Trot Ranch Showmanship 1st & 2nd may participate in the WT Championship Showmanship Horse & Pony class.
- 1. **Walk/Trot 10-13 & 14-18** may only participate in classes designated as Walk/Trot 10-18 and will NOT be eligible for any Championship classes.

Ranch Classes & Division:

- 1. Horse/pony participating in Ranch classes are not eligible for any other Western Pleasure class at this show. Ranch exhibitors may participate in W. Horsemanship, Hunter. Contest & Fence classes.
- 2. No horse/pony may cross enter a Western Showmanship/Ranch Showmanship, Trail/Ranch Trail or Western Pleasure/Ranch Rail class at this show, regardless of the number of exhibitors showing said horse or pony.
- 3. The horse's performance should simulate a horse/pony riding outside the confines of an arena & that of a working ranch horse. This class should show the horse's ability to work at a forward, working speed while under control by the rider. Light contact should be rewarded, and horse does not have to be shown on a full drape of reins. The overall manners and responsiveness of the horse while performing the maneuver requirements, and the horses' quality of movement are the primary considerations.
- 4. Each exhibitor will perform a pattern as designed by the Show Cte.
- 5. Each horse/pony will work individually, performing both required and optional maneuvers, and scored based on 0 to 100, with 70 denoting average.
- 6. Failure to perform a required maneuver within the designated pattern will result in a horse placing below all other horses that perform all maneuvers.
- 7. Hoof polish is discouraged but will not be cause for DQ at this show.
- 8. Banded or Braided manes are discouraged but will not be cause for DQ at this show. However, tail extensions will be cause for DQ.
- 9. Equipment with silver should not count over a good working outfit. Silver on bridles and saddles is discouraged.
- 10. High Point & Reserve High Point will be awarded to each age group using points from Ranch Riding, Ranch Rail & Ranch Trail. In the event of a tie, tie will be broken by placing in Ranch Riding.

Fence Classes & Division: AHSA APPROVED HELMETS MUST BE WORN BY ANYONE WARMING UP OR SHOWING OVER FENCES. THIS INCLUDES EXHIBITORS, TRAINERS, COACHES & PARENTS.

- 1. Crossrails Over X's Open to horses & ponies or riders that have never shown over a course of 2'0" or higher. CANNOT cross enter additional over fence classes except Hunter Hack.
- 2. Beg. Jumpers 2'0" Open to horses & ponies or riders that have never shown over fences above 2'0". Entries in Jumper 2'3" & 2'6" Open to horses & ponies or riders that have never shown over fences above 2'3" or 2'6". Jump off at Judges discretion due to tie (time and faults).
- 3. Western Riding, Reining, Ranch Horse Riding & Fence classes, will be run as follows: Exhibitors in these classes can run their pattern anytime during the allotted class block regardless of age/horse/pony. Once we have moved to the next block or jump height, the previous block is closed.
- 4. Ground Poles, Crossrails, Beg. Jumper & Jumper classes WILL NOT be included in High Pt. Fence Awards.
- 5. Exhibitors in Fence classes will be required to select a fence height on their entry form and may not change heights for the duration of the show.
- 6. W/T Ground poles limited to 9 & Under, W/T 10-13 & 14-18. Beg. Ground Poles open to Beg. Over Fence riders. Trotting is not penalized. Beg. Ground Pole riders may cross enter Crossrails. W/T Exhibitors will not be permitted to enter Crossrails classes.
- 7. High Pt. & Res. High Pt. will be awarded to each age group using points from Eq. Over Fences, Wrkg. Hunter & Hunter Hack. In the event of a tie, the tie will broke by placing in Eq. Over Fences.

SEE RULES #28 & #34 REGARDING TIME BLOCKS FOR WESTERN RIDING, REINING, RANCH RIDING & FENCE CLASSES AT THIS SHOW.

Working Hunter Under Saddle Classes & Championship:

All entries in Wrkg HUS must be shown in a minimum of one over fences class at the same show regardless of division. Management has the option to keep or remove jumps from the ring.

- 1. Exhibitors may not cross enter the same horse/pony in Working Hunter Under Saddle and any Hunter Under Saddle class.
- 2. Fence class choices for Working Hunter Under Saddle will include: Ground Poles, Cross rails, Hunter Hack, Beg. Jumper, Jumper, Wrkg Hunter Over Fences & Eq. Over Fences.
- 3. 1st & 2nd placed exhibitors in Working Hunter Under Saddle, will compete for Working Hunter Under Saddle Championship. Entries must be made in the Show Office after the WHUS classes are completed.
- 4. Working Hunter Under Saddle Championship class will be held in Denny Hales Arena.

Lead Line Classes:

- 1, Lead Line Classes are open to Exhibitors 8 & under.
- 2. Lead Line Exhibitors may not participate in any Walk/Trot or 3 gaited class at this show.
- 3. The person designated as the Handler must be 18 or under and entered as an exhibitor at this show.
- 4. Attire: Exhibitors may show Western, Ranch or Hunt in both Lead Line classes. Handlers may wear matching attire or their choice of appropriate show attire.
- 5. Showmanship Handler can be used if needed, but not required.

PARENTS, TRAINERS, SPECTATORS & EXHIBITORS

- 1. Be prepared! Make sure you have everything you need and give yourself & your horse time to relax & get used to the area. Including the sounds!
- 2. Be a good sport! Treat judges, show management, show staff, other competitors, and all animals with respect.
- 3. Know and follow the rules and guidelines for the specific show.
- 4. Be safe! Keep at least a horse length of space between riders to avoid collisions. Share the space!
- 5. Be mindful! Keep an eye on children and keep dogs on a leash.
- 6. Be aware! That your bad behavior or someone in your groups bad behavior, may affect your entire group or individual. Don't be the one that causes your exhibitor, group or yourself to be scratched without a refund and possibly banned from future AAYHS shows.
- 7. If you feel the need to complain do it in a constructive way! Show management will be more likely to listen and do what is possible to rectify the problem.
- 8. If you feel the need to file a formal protest then follow the proper procedure and file a protest. Formal Protests must be filed with the Show Office within 1 hour after the completion of the class in question. A \$200.00 CASH deposit is required and is forfeited if the protest is not upheld. Protests involving class results or missed classes WILL NOT be accepted. Results of protests will be determined by the Show Steward(s). See rules #17 & #18.

THE ALL AMERICAN YOUTH HORSE SHOW RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REMOVE ANY PERSON, PERSONS OR GROUPS WHO CANNOT ABIDE BY THE RULES OF THE SHOW.
